



SAFETY REMINDERS:



No Nuts or Nut Products Please: We still have some students bringing in items that have nuts or nut products and/or oils. We have several children who have life threatening allergies. Please check all foods and food packages to be sure they do not contain any nut products, or nut oils. Thank you.

Strollers: Unfortunately, we **cannot allow** strollers into our school, as it **does not meet with Fire Regulations**. We are sorry for this inconvenience. As an alternative, you may wish to lock your stroller to the fence outside (you would have to provide the lock yourself). Also, we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. I apologize for the inconvenience, and thank you for following this rule.
