Parking Lot:

- Please monitor and walk **WITH** your child(ren) as you walk around or enter the parking lot

- Please do **NOT** park in the **accessible parking spaces**, as we do have staff, students and parents who require these spots.
- Walking is great exercise, and a nice way to spend time with your children, so **AVOID** the parking lot, and **walk**. 😊



REMINDERS:

- Please **do not** bring any **food with nuts or nut products** to school. We have several children with life threatening

allergies. Please check all foods and food packages to be sure they do not contain any nut products or nut oils. Thank you.

- **Absences/Lates:** Attendance and punctuality is critical for your child’s learning, achievement and well-being. Cold Weather

- Please be sure your child(ren) is/are dressed appropriately for the weather. Students will be waiting outside before and after school, and they will be going out for recess each day – weather permitting.



- On rainy, or extremely cold weather days, students will be brought into the gym, in the morning. Please say good-bye to your child(ren) at the door as we do not have enough room in the gym to accommodate parents and children. Thank you.
- Also, please do not stand/linger by the entry door in the lobby. Crowding in this area is a safety concern. Thank you.

Checking in at the Office: When visiting Central School, please ring the buzzer, and upon entry, **go directly to the office to check in.** Please do not escort your child to the classrooms, we will do that for you. For the safety of all, we cannot have parents/guardians in the hallways. Many of our students are afraid of strangers, and our halls get very crowded. Thank you. If you are dropping off something for your child, please leave it at the office, and we will deliver it to your child. Also, in order for your children to lose less class time, it would be helpful to make appointments after 3:05 p.m.

Visitors/Volunteers: If you are visiting or volunteering at Central, please sign in on the appropriate sign-in list in the office. This is very important, as if we have an emergency in the building, we need to know that everyone in the building is accounted for, and safe. Thank you very much for this.
