




PRACTICE LOCKDOWN AND BOMB THREAT

Dear Parents and members of our community;

We are in need of EQAO Scribes

A <u>scribe</u> is an individual who supports the accommodations the student receives on a regular basis for all forms of assessment. Scribes must not be relatives of the students they are assessing.

A scribe must/may

- print by hand or type exactly what the student dictates;
- fill in the circles on the Student Answer Sheet as directs by the student;
- read the dictation back to the student is requested;
- assume each sentence begins with a capital and ends with a period (for reading and math only);
- print by hand or type exactly what the student dictates as one long statement with no
 punctuation or capitalization. The scribe is permitted to spell words correctly (for writing only);
- show the student the transcription, after the student has finished dictating his or her work, and
 ask the student to indicate where capital letters and punctuation should be placed (for writing
 only);



Music and the Sounds of Summer Fun!


