



An Evening with Dr. Mahoney: Learning about ADHD

Dr. William Mahonev is a Developmental Pediatrician who has worked with children and families in the Hamilton area since 1981. He is a Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics at McMaster University and works with the McMaster Autism Research Team (MacART). Dr. Mahoney works with children with developmental disabilities, language, learning, and attentional disorders. He will be joining us on June 13 for an in-depth discussion of ADHD. Dr. Mahoney will speak to what is known about why children have ADHD and share information about the treatment of this disorder.
