Dear Chedoke Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to share that Chedoke School will officially become a Construction Site on Monday, May 27th, as we begin to create a Natural Play Space for our students and our community.




As a result, the following changes will be put into place to ensure the safety of our students:

- **Our current Kindergarten Playground will be closed to students, staff and parents.**
- Students exiting the buses in the Morning will now enter the Playground walking west along Bendamere Ave. and North along West 27th Street.
- JK and SK students will congregate on the lawn, with painted boundaries, between the school and the parking lot.
- During recess times, the SK students, with pennies on and Grade 1 /2 helpers, will access the larger playground. (This is a Chedoke Tradition as our students prepare for Grade 1.)
- During recess times, the JK students will access the painted grass area.
- At 2:45 pm, all Kindergarten students will be dismissed to parents who are driving/walking and students accessing the buses, from the gym ONLY. The South Door on West 27th Street, will be available to parents picking their students. Students travelling on buses, will exit the school through the front doors.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school. Keep in mind that this is a time of transition, but the outcome will benefit all and safety continues to be our priority.

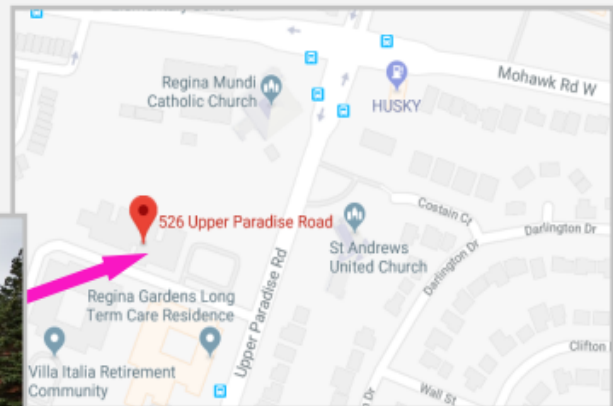

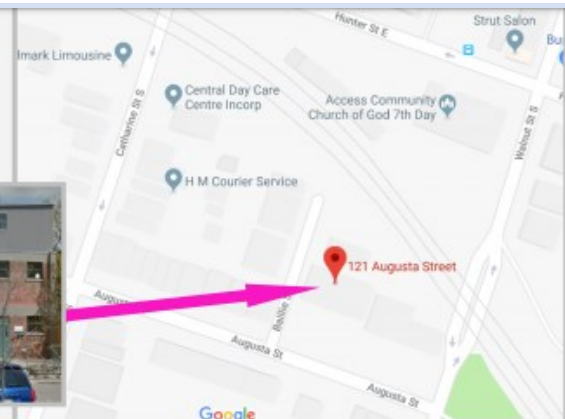
