Challenges

- •Communication and Engagement technology and software is new to families, staff, and students/sometimes doesn't work
- ·iPad Collection and Redistribution communication; chargers and cables not coming back; clean data; inventory; redistribution
- ·Targeted Intervention in new learning environment
- -Well-being of everyone working through this pandemic involves dealing daily with uncertainty, change, and anxiety.

Elementary Reorganization:

- -System-wide reduction in number of students attending in-school learning option
- Compared to last year down about 130 students
- ·Loss of 2.4 FTE Teachers and 1.0FTE ECE

Supporting Our Students Through On-Line Learning:

- ·LRTs provide consultations to Teachers in Remote School and some direct instruction to students.
- ·EAs provide some support to students on an IEP in the Remote School
- -Special Class Teacher teachers some students in the class exclusively through MS Teams
- ·All Teachers have an on-line learning platform (The Hub or MS Teams) to provide assignments to students who cannot attend school due to illness.

Maintaining Focus On School Improvement:

- All Students Reading
- -Gr. 2 students who did not reach standard last year
- -K-1 students who are showing lagging reading skills

Considerations

- -Which students are at-risk of not reading?
- ·Who are our most vulnerable and under-served students?
- ·How can we coordinate supports and interventions to mitigate impact of pandemic so all students become readers?

- ·We are doing an Orange and Black Day to celebrate Halloween.
