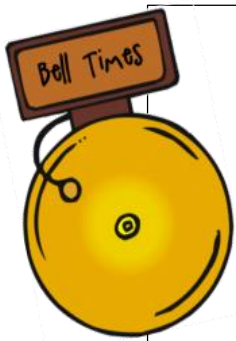

Attestation and Daily Screener

The Attestation form must be completed for your child to attend school. It is found in the HWDSB Parent Portal. If you are having difficulty accessing the Parent Portal, please follow the troubleshooting steps on-line before calling the office.

Please initial the screening calendar found in their agenda for each child to confirm they have passed and can come to school. Teachers check these calendars each morning. Thank-you!

Dropping Off and Picking Up You Child(ren)

The school parking lot is for staff only. Please do not park there.

Students in grades K-3/4 can be dropped off and picked up at their designated areas each day. When coming on to school grounds, please remember to wear a mask.

Students in grades 4/5-8 are expected to be dropped off and picked up along West 25th and 27th Streets, especially south of Bendamere Ave where both sides of the street can be used. This will help reduce congestion at the front of the building.

When driving to or from school, please remember to follow all signage in our community, including speed limits and no parking signs. Also, please do not park in front of driveways. Thanks.

VENTILATION MESSAGE FOR SCHOOL NEWSLETTERS

Ventilation is an important protective measure for safe school environments. Over the course of the summer, HWDSB has worked to improve ventilation in various locations ahead of the 2021-22 school year. These upgrades include projects funded through Canada and Ontario’s CVRIS-EDU program and about 1,039 High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) units being shipped to classrooms and schools. The HEPA units have been provided in accordance with Ministry of Education direction. This includes all

Kindergarten spaces, schools without mechanical ventilation (Tier 3), and where there is active ventilation projects underway and not yet completed. There are three tiers of ventilation as identified by the Ministry of Education. They are Tier 1 (supply, return, exhaust), Tier 2 (supply, exhaust) and Tier 3 (exhaust). Tier 3 schools are typically heated with radiators and have exhaust units for moving air. These schools will be receiving HEPA units to help improve ventilation.

CHEDOKE SCHOOL IS A TIER 1 SCHOOL AS DEFINED BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION.
