Summer Learning Opportunities through Continuing Education (Grades 6-8)

International Languages Elementary (IILE) Program

Kindergarten to Grade 8 are eligible to participate. The IILE program exists to educate our students with a new language and/or strengthen their skills in the language(s) of their choice. Students will learn to speak, listen, read, and write in these lessons, as well as have assigned homework, and opportunity to participate in class. IILE Classes include:

- On-line programs 1.5-hour synchronous lesson per day (over MS Teams) in addition to assigned work or
- In-Person programs 2.5 hours of In-Person instruction per day

Summer Literacy and Numeracy Skill Builder Programs

<u>Current Grade 8's transitioning to Grade 9</u> can earn a half credit or a full credit before starting High School We are offering Civics and Careers courses to all Grade 8's who will transition to Grade 9 in the fall.
