HUMAN DEVELOPMENT & SEXUAL HEALTH

The Ministry of Education has introduced a revised Ontario Curriculum: Health Physical Education Grades 1 - 8, (2019) to replace the interim 2018 document. There is also a new Program/Policy Memorandum 162: Exemption from Instruction related to the Human Development and Sexual Health Expectations, Grades - 8, (2019) to 1 curriculum accompany the updated document. This memorandum outlines the process for communicating with families about Growth and Development and Strand D: Sexual Health and the process for parents/guardians to exempt their child(ren) from this learning.

HWDSB has informed elementary parents/ guardians that learning on Strand D: Growth and Development and Sexual Health will occur in May and June. Here are what families can expect as we approach these dates:

- A system Teams Live event for families previewing the curriculum will be held on Tuesday April 25th from 6:30-7:30P.M.
- All parent information, including a recording of the presentation can be found at: https://www.hwdsb.on.ca/elementary/programs/human-development/
- Parents will need to complete an exemption form, in the Parent Portal, if they want their children exempted and email it to the school. Paper copies and or phone calls are also acceptable
- Teachers will send individual letters regarding classroom activities and learning to parents/guardians in May.
