GRADE 3 and 6 EQAO

Annually, the Education Quality and Accountability Office, EQAO, assesses Grade Three and Six students in the areas of Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

The purpose of the assessment is to ensure that our education system is preparing students for success. It is based on the Ontario Curriculum and a grading format is used to ensure that children are scored in a consistent, fair manner.

The information gathered in the assessments is provided to parents/caregivers and to the school. It is used to assist in school planning in the following year. For example, the EQAO data can help us, as a Staff, identify where our students excel and where additional support and instruction is needed.



If there are questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to call the school and speak to your child's teacher.

URGENT: VOLUNTEER DIRECTIVE



If you are planning on joining your child on any class trips, year-end trips, or helping in the classroom, school or on sporting events as a volunteer, you **MUST** have an updated Criminal Reference Check – Vulnerable Screener. CRCs are done on-line or at the Police Station at a cost. It could take approximately 6 - 8 weeks for this process to be completed.
