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## A Message for our Grade 5 Families

I hope you and your family are all staying safe as we begin to enjoy the warmer weather!

The form will ask you to upload a picture of your grade 5 child as well as their favourite memory of Cootes Paradise. The form will also ask you for your consent to post your child's name, picture, and favourite memory.

Parents/guardians who do not want their child recognized as part of the commemorative video should include this on the MS form in the appropriate checkbox.

- Verification of date of arrival/immigration documents (if the child was not born in Canada).
