	Where proof of screening is not provided, the school will contact the family to receive verbal confirmation.
Parent Access to School	Access to the school will be very limited for parents, volunteers and visitors. Contact the main office before coming to the school to speak with a staff member.

Bus loading and unloading	<ul> <li>School buses will load and unload at the back of the playground on Glen Rd.</li> </ul>
	• In accordance to Public Health Protocols, all students on the
	bus must wear a mask and sit in their assigned seats. Family
	members will be seated together. Only one bus will be
	loaded or unloaded at a time in order to ensure physical
	distancing.

School Parking Lat	The school parking let is closed to all percents and visiters
School Parking Lot	<ul> <li>The school parking lot is closed to all parents and visitors.</li> <li>Active transportation (walk/bike) is encouraged to reduce the amount of traffic at the start/end of the day.</li> <li>Parents/Guardians driving their children to school are encouraged to drop and walk at a location near to the school.</li> </ul>
Entry and Exit for Students	Parents/Guardians are asked to drop their children off at the entry
	gates at the back playground while maintaining physical distancing.
	Students can begin to enter the school yard <u>no earlier than 9:00 am.</u>
	FDK students:
	<ul> <li>Parents/Guardians may accompany a student to the kindergarten pen entry gate. Educators will accompany students to their cohort line.</li> <li>Students/parents must physically distance (2m) from other</li> </ul>
	families/staff while on school property.
	<ul> <li>Adults must wear face coverings when on school property.</li> <li>Bussed students will be supervised from and to the bus loading area.</li> </ul>
	Grades 1-5 students:
	<ul> <li>Parents/Guardians are permitted to walk students to their pod location while observing physical distancing (2m) and wearing a face covering.</li> <li>When students enter the school yard, they are to proceed directly to their designated class location (marked) and line up with their face mask on.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>At the end of the day, students K – Gr. 3 (unless bussing) will be dismissed directly to parents from their outdoor designated class location.</li> </ul>
	YMCA:
	<ul> <li>Any students who are part of the YMCA afterschool program will be dismissed from their pod to their YMCA lead.</li> </ul>
	Please note:
	• Upon dismissal, all students must leave school property in a timely fashion.
	Adults must wear face coverings while on school property.
	• Students/parents must physically distance (2m) from other families/staff while on school property.
Movement Around the School	Students will remain with their class cohort throughout the day.

Student Belongings <ul> <li>Use of lockers/hooks/cubbies will ensure physical distancing from students in other cohorts.</li> <li>Shared use of lockers/hooks/cubbies may take place withi a cohort or family.</li> <li>Students will keep work materials at their desks.</li> <li>**Please note: All personal items (toys, stuffies/plush toys, cards, balls etc) <u>must</u> be kept at home.</li> </ul> <li>Class Set Up         <ul> <li>A sink or hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms.</li> <li>Each student is assigned a work-space area that ensures distancing from others.</li> <li>All desks are forward facing.</li> <li>Where tables are used, use a physical divider (plexi) where available to separate students (optional).</li> <li>All required work materials are located at student's workspace Students may share learning materials with hand washing/sanitizing. These materials will be cleaned c a regular basis.</li> </ul> </li> <li>FDK</li> <li>Morning entry:         <ul> <li>Students will meet their cohort in the designated pods.</li> <li>Parent/Guardians may accompany a student to the kindergarten pen entry. Educators will accompany student to their cohort line.</li> <li>Parents must wear face coverings when on school propert</li> <li>Bussed students will be supervised from and to the bus loading area.</li> <li>Dismissal:             <ul> <li>Teachers will accompany students to their designated Pod</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li>		<ul> <li>Students remain in their classrooms throughout the day.</li> <li>Subject specific teachers will travel to classes to provide instruction.</li> <li>When moving about the school, students/classes will walk on the right side, maintaining physical distancing.</li> <li>**All students K-5 must wear a non-medical mask while in the school</li> </ul>
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<ul> <li>For parents of students in K-3, Parents must remain physically distanced and wear masks when on school property.</li> <li>Note: No plush toys permitted.</li> </ul>	FDK	<ul> <li>Morning entry:</li> <li>Students will meet their cohort in the designated pods.</li> <li>Parent/Guardians may accompany a student to the kindergarten pen entry. Educators will accompany students to their cohort line.</li> <li>Parents must wear face coverings when on school property.</li> <li>Bussed students will be supervised from and to the bus loading area.</li> <li>Dismissal:</li> <li>Teachers will accompany students to their designated Pod line.</li> <li>For parents of students in K-3, Parents must remain physically distanced and wear masks when on school property.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Classes may be held in the gym with cleaning of high touchpoints throughout the day.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Change rooms are open to single cohorts with masking and distancing.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Students are encouraged to come dressed in comfortable clothes</li> </ul>
	Music
	• Wind instruments may be used indoors with distancing.
	<ul> <li>Singing may take place indoors with students wearing masks.</li> </ul>
	• The music teacher will be travelling from class to class.
	Loorning Commons
	<ul> <li>Learning Commons</li> <li>Learning Commons may be scheduled for one class at a</li> </ul>
	time (book exchange permitted).
Nutrition Breaks	<ul> <li>Nutrition breaks will be staggered – alternating outdoor times so that half the students will be out at one time.</li> <li>Students eat in their classrooms at their workspace area, while abiding by safety considerations that include washing/sanitizing hands prior to eating, before going outside and when returning inside.</li> <li>No sharing of food or beverages.</li> <li>Each class has a designated outdoor play area.</li> <li>Outdoor play spaces have been marked.</li> <li>Students may remove masks during outdoor play and place these in a secure area (ie. Pocket, brown paper bag etc).</li> </ul>
Washroom Use	<ul> <li>Students will use washrooms closest to their classrooms.</li> <li>Occupancy limits will be posted outside washrooms.</li> <li>Markings outside washrooms for physical distancing of students awaiting entry.</li> <li>Students maintain physical distancing while in washrooms.</li> <li>Urinals and stalls: every other one marked off.</li> <li>Students may use hand dryers or paper towels.</li> </ul>
Hydration Stations	Water fountains have been closed.

Clubs and Extracurriculars	<ul> <li>Students use Hydration Station to fill labelled water bottle.</li> <li>Students will maintain physical distancing in line ups.</li> <li>Students are encouraged to bring their own labelled water bottle.</li> <li>Clubs and extracurriculars may take place for mixed cohorts</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>(masking and distancing required).</li> <li>No outside program providers will come into schools.</li> </ul>
Nutrition Programs	<ul> <li>All Nutrition Programs such as Tastebuds are 'Grab and Go'.</li> <li>Food is delivered in bins to each classroom.</li> <li>Food sales have been suspended at this time.</li> </ul>
Ill or Injured Students	<ul> <li>Ill or injured students will wait in a separate supervised area located outside of the office.</li> <li>The school office will contact parents immediately to come to the school for pick up.</li> </ul>
Mask Rules	<ul> <li>All students must wear a non-medical mask or face covering on school buses and in the school. Contact [insert contact info] if you have any concerns about your student wearing a mask/face covering.</li> <li>Masks will be provided to students who forget to bring one.</li> </ul>
