7. Principal's Report	<ul> <li>Ms. Hogan reported on the following: <ul> <li>a. Increase in enrollment this year – During the pandemic, 408 students were enrolled to attend in person. Now, 639 students are enrolled. We are back to pre-pandemic attendance levels.</li> <li>b. School has Mandarin immersion and French immersion programs. Mandarin immersion is unique to Cootes Paradise Elementary.</li> <li>c. Classroom changes – shift from an English grade 2/3 class to a straight grade 2 class; the opening of an additional English grade 3 class; and a shift from a English grade 1/2 class to a full grade 1 class.</li> <li>d. School focus on increasing extracurricular activities and programming, e.g., cross-country meet on September 28, 2022.</li> <li>e. Parent volunteer opportunities – parents need to get their vulnerable sector check from Hamilton Police in order to be able to participate.</li> <li>f. Gates are being installed in open areas of back playground.</li> <li>g. Outdoor natural playground areas need to be updated to ensure safety – wood surfaces were not properly treated – recent slipping incident in Kinderyard.</li> <li>h.
