Fundraising Events:

- Pumpkin Hike
 - very successful (profit \$1767.34)
 - we covered costs, will vote on how to split remaining proceeds to support the RBG,
 McMaster Fridge, and class trips
- Spirit Wear also successful, although the proceeds will be small because we set prices low to be accessible
 - we will need volunteers (with vulnerable sector check) to hand out the spirit wear before break

Festival of Lights (Nov 16)

- new event
- we have permit for Churchill Park Clubhouse (following success of pumpkin night)
- proceeds to Food4Kids, which supports local community
- also running a sock drive for school, as suggested by school administration
- Volunteers
 - don't need vulnerable sector check
 - anyone who is a voting member has liability insurance through H&S
- Cookies:
 - Jean reports on Weils
 - Natalia suggests requesting donations from school community
 - Rosalee suggest "Planted in Hamilton" on Locke St. for vegan/gluten free cookies
 - Kara suggests Marcy's bakery (Kara to call)

Rosalee van Staalduinen: Nov 15 School Council Meeting Report

- School Council members did a training
- Created a fundraising subcommittee
- engaged in conversation with admin to discuss how to increase community engagement
 - discussed tone, delivery, and content of messaging between school and parent community
 - clarifying access to school property, such as volunteering
- organizing a staff appreciation event on Tuesday Dec 13th
- Approved motions
 - work with H&S and admin to access resources for enhancing student learning
 - organizing a talent show in New Year
 - draft letter to special education advisory committee with school board requesting further support and educational assistants for students at Cootes. admin agreed

Meeting Dates to Approve:

- Proposed dates: Jan 25, March 29, May 16, June 21
- Natalia motions to approve, Lisa seconds
- Kara asks Rosalee about possibility of making magnets with meeting dates for both School Council and Home and School

Budget:

- last year's H&S exec had approved budget for this year, but we need to approve our revised budget (which reflects loss of expected revenue and new/different events)
- Kara presented the differences between the previous budget and the revised budget
- Rosalee asks: will budget be posted to school website?
 - yes, we are working to update the school website
- Motion to approve: Natalia, second: Ashley
 - Vote passes unanimously
- Rosalee asks about accessing funds to support learning initiative from School Council
 - Kara references budget items: library enhancements, trip subsidies. Natalia: we are also looking to create guidelines for H&S to manage requests for funds
- Budget vote passes unanimously
- Pumpkin Hike Proceeds:
 - we want to vote on how much we want to donate to McMaster Community Fridge
 - Natalia: moves to allocate 30% to Mac and 20% to RBG, Erin seconds
 - vote passes unanimously

- Proceeds allocation:
 - \$250 to RBG
 - \$500 to McMaster Community Fridge
- Future Event Proceeds:
 - Natalia: moves to allocate 30% of proceeds to designated cause of each event, Ashley seconds

Festival of Lights operating costs:

- want to donate all of proceeds of this event to Food4Kids, as this replaces the inreach gift card program of previous years
- Vote to use savings for operating costs (likely \$500-600) passes unanimously

Request Items:

- we will let teachers know how much we are allocating for them to access
- we also entertain other requests
- we did have a request item:
 - movie theater rental (\$241.70 x2)
 - vote passes unanimously to grant request
- Churchill Park Skating rinks:
 - run by volunteers
 - consider donating to help pay for tarps
 - Natalia move to donate some funds from savings to help rinks (\$800)
 - Vote passes unanimously

Home and School Executive Council Meetings

- meet every other month
- they represent all of the H&S associations across the Board
- school has new snow clearing policy:
 - Board has voted on hiring outside contractors for snow removal
