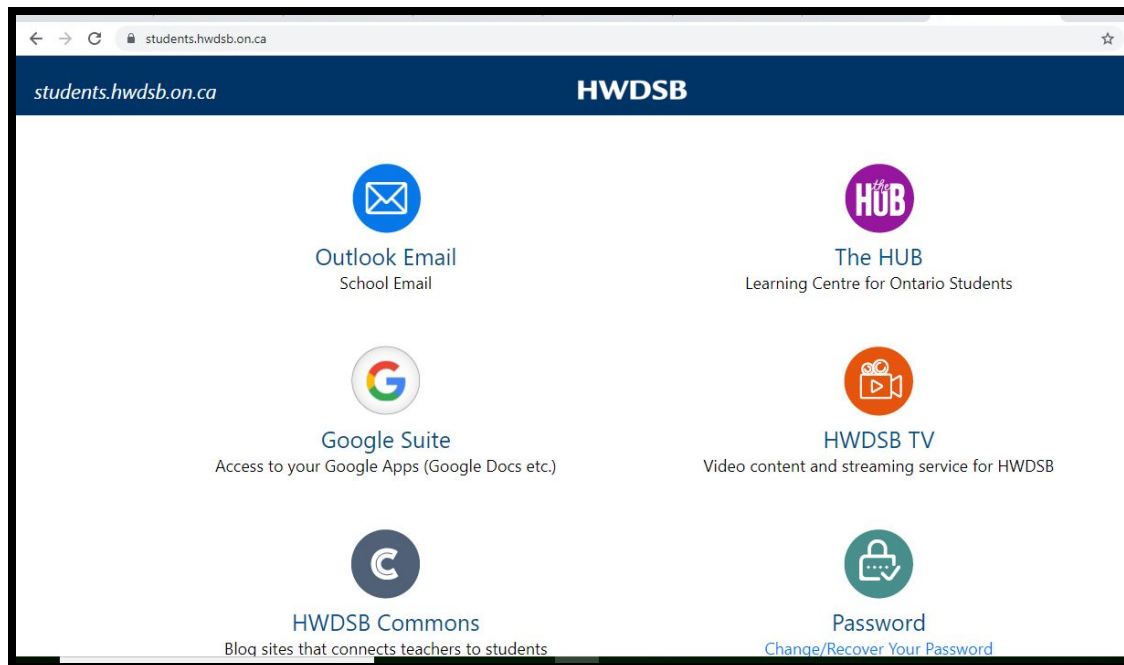

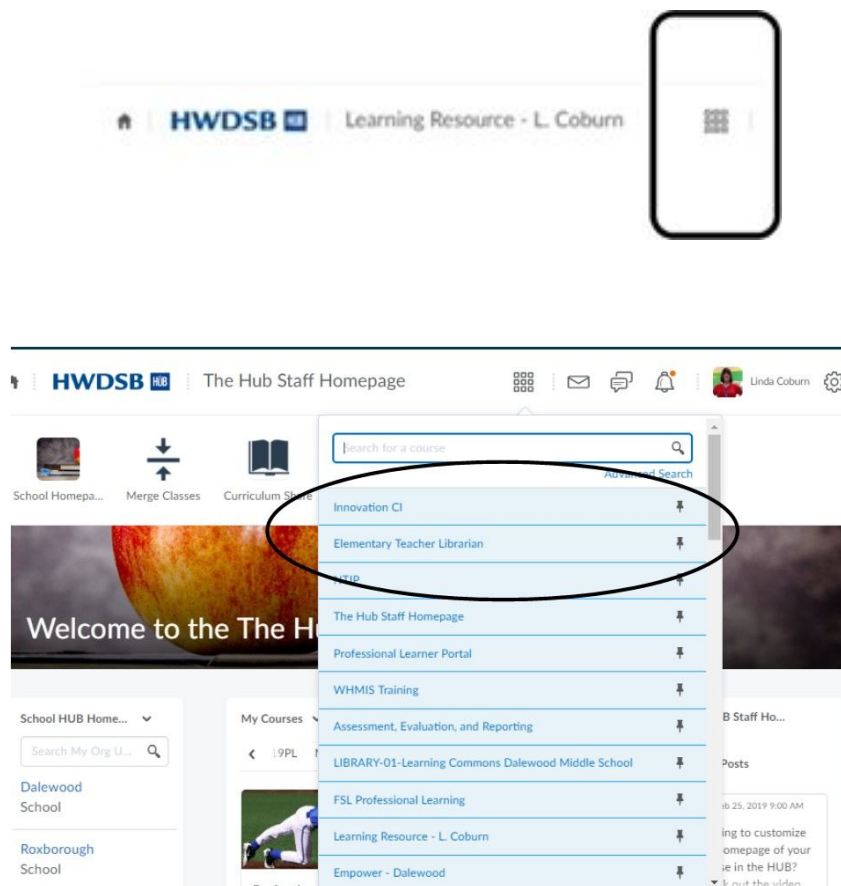

Step 1: Go to the waffle at the top right and select the course you want, either:

1. Learning Resource – L. Coburn
2. Empower - Dalewood
3. Teacher or Classroom Name



Step 2: Select a Course below for further instructions (Note: you can pin your most used courses to the top by clicking the pin black next to it.)

Math) then select the subject unit such as Fractions or (eg. Music) then Chrome Music or Geography (Encounters with Canada-French) 4. The lessons will sometimes appear in the order in which they are to be completed in most cases. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select the Content tab at the top 2. Select the module (for example Discussions) from the tab on the left 3. Check with the teacher for the module you will be working on each day 4. 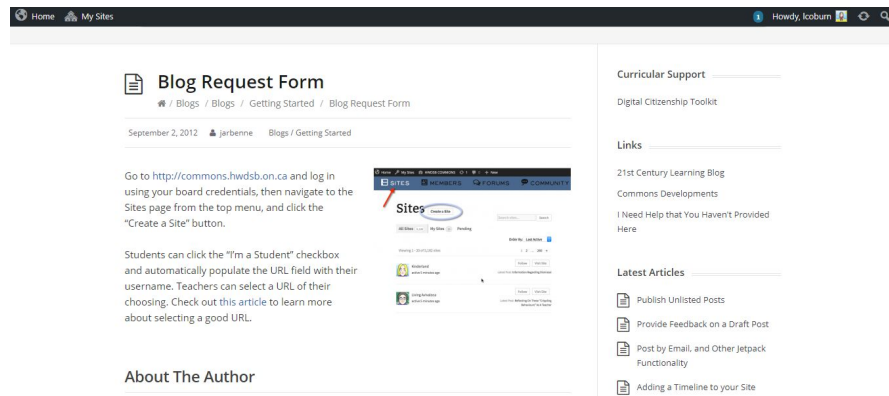

1. Go to <http://commons.hwdsb.on.ca> and log in using your board credentials, then navigate to the Sites page from the top menu, and click the “Create a Site” button.
2. Students can click the “I’m a Student” checkbox and automatically populate the URL field with their username. Teachers can select a URL of their choosing. Check out [this article](#) to learn more about selecting a good URL.
3. Now you can just enter HWDSB Commons, login and go to My Sites and it will appear once it has been approved by the board Commons Administrator.
4. To add a post and page select them from the menu on the left.
5. Visit your site from the tab at the top and see the magic happen!
6. Note sometimes it may take 24 hours to pend from the board.
