







## Virtual Library Databases for Secondary Schools

- Login to *The Hub* with your student username

- Use the *QuickLinks* to access the most popular databases

## Great eResources for Secondary



**PowerSearch** - Search multiple databases in 1 click. Results from 40 Gale databases. Article citations, translations, highlighting, word-to-voice feature.



**Britannica Image Quest** - Contains over 3 million rights-cleared images for assignments, activities, student reports and projects, newsletters, flyers.



**Britannica School-High** - Four encyclopedia, over 120,000 articles, atlases, dictionaries, timelines and multimedia.



**Canadian Points of View** - A full-text database designed to provide students with essays that present multiple sides of over 100 key current issues.



**CultureGrams** - Provides concise, reliable, and up-to-date cultural information on hundreds of countries, the Canadian provinces and the U.S. states.



**eMax (Sora) e-Book Library** - Over 5000 e-books and e-audiobooks. A valid OEN number is required. Sora app available.



**Learn 360 Videos** - Thousands of streamed educational videos. Also includes images, audio, printables, articles. Features Canadian content.
