- Science fairs: because the focus of the science fair work is done at home, many students don't have the support in the evenings and it doesn't make it easily accessible for many of the students at the school, these types of things are not part of the board curriculum and therefore no teacher support, many teachers decide on what extra curricular activities they do, if they choose to do it

Bike week:

- If funding allows for the \$1000 that bike week costs would like to do that again
- The grades 4/5 student got to learn how to ride bikes and about bike safety, this is also a great educational experience

Hydro one funds and subcommittee:

- Looking for people that are interested in joining.
- The funds are about \$133 000 and need to be decided on how to use it.
- The funds to be used are to be decided by the School Council and the Beasley Neighbourhood Association.

 This money is in reserve due to the construction/renovation of the power station and how the construction changed the access to the park.

Principal's report:

 Parents are reminded that they should avoid dropping off their kids in the parking lot of the school. There have been accidents, people double park and it's not safe for students. It's a real concern that children or staff or caregivers will be hit by cars. It's advised to park along Ferguson, Wilson or walk.
