Principal's Message

The arrival of spring brings with it fresh blooms, green grass and a flurry of activity in our school! Our wonderful staff have planned a wide array of curricular and extra-curricular activities to help our students demonstrate their year of learning and celebrate their successes. As well, there is a considerable amount of information below regarding the processes we will go through in the next few months to plan for next year.

Information Regarding the 2018/2019 School Year School Information

Dundana will continue to operate in the 2018/2019 school year with bell times of 8:55 and 3:15, with two nutrition breaks at 10:35-11:15 and 12:55-1:35 daily. One change to our schedule will see our students going outside each nutrition break before coming in to eat. If you are eligible for bussing, you will receive notification in August from the Transportation department. **Those not eligible are welcome to submit courtesy rider requests, however, these are not guaranteed and will not begin until later in the fall.** Courtesy rider requests will be available in the school office in June and in September if you wish to fill one out. Decisions about accepting courtesy riders will depend on space and rider needs.

We are still accepting registrations for JK and SK students in our English catchment area. We are also able to accept Grade 1 to 5 students to our English catchment program if they live in this catchment area, and grade 2 to 5 French Immersion (FI) students transferring directly from another FI school program and are within our French catchment area. Students wishing to be registered in Grade 1 FI will need to register centrally at www.hwdsb.on.ca/fi For specific questions about the FI registration process, families are encouraged to contact fi@hwdsb.on.ca

Please note that we are unable to accept any registrations that are from outside of our catchment area. If you are unsure about which school you are in catchment for, please go to www.hwdsb.on.ca/find/ and submit your address, or contact the school and we can run that information for you.

Class Planning

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Registration

We have begun our planning already for the next school year to ensure successful transitions for all of our students. Later this spring, we will be building our classes for the year ahead. The staff collectively make these decisions as they have a wealth of knowledge about individual student strengths and needs, as well as student combinations that best enhance learning for all. We know that parents and guardians may also have additional information about your child that could contribute to our decision making. If there is particular information that you would like us to consider in placing your child (e.g. a student's particular strengths or needs, pairings of students that either are beneficial or detrimental to your child's learning), please advise me via email at kkeerybi@hwdsb.on.ca Please note that requests for specific teachers cannot be accepted and will not be considered. Submissions are requested on or

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before May 31st to be considered, but cannot be guaranteed. We will endeavour to create the best learning environment we can for every student.

Combined Grade Classes

Please note that, like other schools around the province, we will continue to have many classes with combined grades next year. This is a reality of caps to class sizes, but it is also encouraged as a positive practice from both the Ministry of Education and our school board. With approaches to learning that incorporate inquiry, student directed learning, differentiated education and student-specific goal setting and feedback, our teachers are well versed in providing the best learning opportunities for their students, even in combined grades.

Planning for Re-Organization

If our classes grow too large or too small in September, re-organization of classes is likely to occur in October. This process happens every year and is dictated to us by the board to meet Ministry standards regarding class size. If re-organization is required, students affected will be moved. Please be aware of the possibility that your child may have to move to a new class or have a new teacher, in October.
