### **Principal's Message**

March and April often feature a turning point in the school year. It is a time when lightbulbs go off over students' heads about difficult concepts they have worked on for months. We start to see the maturity and growth in students, particularly in the way they use the strategies they have been taught, both for academic and well being areas of need. The weather (hopefully!) turns a corner and we start to see hints of life begin to peek out. It is difficult for students to maintain the momentum of a school year for ten months at a time, but I hope you will help us find ways to continue to encourage your child(ren) to build or maintain their learning in this last term of the school year. ### **Enhanced Rules for Smoking on School Property**

There are new rules for smoking cannabis and tobacco, and vaping on any school property for all students, staff, families and visitors. Smoking cannabis or tobacco and vaping any substance is prohibited anywhere on school property and in public areas within 20 metres of the perimeter of the school grounds. If you are caught smoking or vaping in school or on school property, you may be ticketed or fined. Please be aware of these new restrictions around all of our schools.
