Principal Report

Around mid-February, we passed that illustrious day celebrated by 5 and 6 year olds in education: the hundredth day of school. It's really interesting (and amusing, at times) to hear our youngest students talk about the concept of what a hundred is, particularly in relation to the concept of time. Descriptions from our recent celebration had students describing those first hundred days as both "a little while" and "so many years". Young students aren't the only ones who feel this way, though. By March, students and educators alike feel as if we have simultaneously just gotten started and have been working on our learning goals for ages. As a parent or guardian, helping your child keep focused and motivated on the learning still to be done between March and June can be a struggle. Encouraging your child to reflect on the goals he/she set in September and/or January – academics, learning skills, social skills – and helping define the next steps and plan to achieve them is a support every student can benefit from.

While report cards (grades 1 to 5) and Communications of Learning (Kindergarten) were not printed and distributed in February due to work to rule restrictions, the educators did assess and evaluate students for first term. Your child is eligible for the two year kindergarten program in the calendar year that he/she turns four (JK) or five (SK). You are welcome to begin your registration in person at the school office between 9:30 and 2:30 weekdays or online (see https://www.hwdsb.on.ca/kindergarten/). All families will need to complete registration at the school, providing:

□ Proof of age (child's birth certificate or passp

- ☐ Proof of address (identification showing custodial guardian's address)
- ☐ Completed Kindergarten Registration form (online or paper copy)
- ☐ Proof of immunization
- ☐ Verification of date of arrival/immigration documents (if the child was not born in Canada)

Please note that we are only able to accept registrations from families who are in our English catchment area. We will send out information about this in the spring to all of our registered families. A brief tour of the Kindergarten classrooms will occur at that time.
