Principal Message

We have had a great first month back at school. Students and educators have spent time getting back into routines and reintroducing methods of learning, communicating, and collaborating. As public health restrictions have reduced, we have been able to resume a number of activities in the school, such as our recent Terry Fox Run, and our upcoming Meet the Teacher. However, it is important to note that there continue to be supports to the health of people in the school, such as hepa filters in each classroom, a mask-friendly environment, student and staff/visitor masks available when needed at the office, and a continued encouragement to complete the online screener when unsure about whether it is best to send your child to school or not. We are looking forward to what awaits us for the rest of the school year!

Volunteering at Dundana

As special activities such as excursions and extra curriculars resume, we are in need of volunteers who can support. As well, some educators may also be looking for some in-class support. Board policy requires all of our volunteers to complete an application, show a recent (issued in last 6 months) vulnerable sector screener and access some training (can be sent to you to complete independently). If you have previously been a volunteer, a renewal agreement is needed each year, along with an offense declaration (vulnerable screener is valid for three years of volunteering before it also needs renewal). Please contact the school if you would like an initial Volunteer Package or a renewal package and we'll get you started. Thank you, in advance, for helping our school community with your time and effort.

Safe Travels Around Dundana

Entry and dismissal times are very busy around the school. All Dundana families are reminded:

- Unless you are part of Umbrella Before/After School program, students should not be arriving unsupervised on the playground until 8:40 a.m. when supervision begins and students need to be picked up by 3:30 p.m. when supervision ends.
- If you are driving to drop off/pick up, please proceed slowly on Dundana Avenue, watch for pedestrians and keep our bus lanes clear of parked and stopped vehicles.
- Students who arrive at school after the 8:55 bell are advised to come to the front door for entry. If you are in before announcements, you can head straight to your class. If announcements have occurred, please come to the office to notify us that you are here.
