Re-Organization 2023/2024

Each year, our school begins with a specific number of classes and teachers. These numbers are estimates based on the previous school year. The Ministry of Education has established class size goals that all school boards are required to adhere to. Each year in September, the Board begins the process of reviewing enrollment and staffing needs through a re-organization process. During this process the actual enrollment is compared to the projected enrollment. As a result, some students may be required to move to another class to balance class sizes in alignment with the Ministry's expectations. At Dundana we experienced a small change this year. Our Grade 3/4FI class has become a straight Grade 3 FI class. Grade 4 students that were in 3/4FI moved to one of the Grade 4 FI classes.

Morning Drop Off

Please be reminded morning supervision does not begin until 8:40am. While there may be adults outdoors earlier then 8:40am, those adults are staff of Umbrella (before and after school program). They supervise students in the Umbrella Program only. Students should not be dropped off prior to 8:40am.
