1. Welcome:

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4.**Teacher's report & Teacher requests**: Mme Eastwood

- -Thank you on behalf of Ms. Jurski and the staff for the council's support of Rocks & Rings
- -Feedback for Pizza Helpers: the grade 5s have been very helpful. We will debrief next Wednesday. An adult is necessary for one of the classes.
- -Mrs. Clarke: the Board is no longer funding The Forest of Reading (package of books). We missed the deadline for this academic year. We could potentially use funds from the Read-athon for the books for next year. TBD.
- -Scholastic French books for the Junior level is limited. Donations of French books would be welcomed.
- -Scientists in Schools: Ontario is mainly 60 min online workshops rather than in-person. It costs approx. \$235 for 30 students. Mme Eastwood will chat with staff and get feedback regarding the online workshops. Kelly mentioned David Suzuki's take on online workshops being more eco-friendly.
- -A group from McMaster called Let's Talk Science is coming in to talk to the students (free).
- -Mad Science: to look into it for in-class presentations.
- -Approximately 100 chairs are missing from the gym. It was noticeable at the Winter Showcase. We should ask other schools if there are spare chairs they could donate.
- -Brian mentioned that 100 new chairs would likely cost upwards of \$5000. We would really need to consider spending that amount of money on chairs.
- -Winter Showcase Feedback: We may need to adjust the physical lights so they shine properly on the students. Teachers are not necessarily aware of the lighting while they are doing dress rehearsals.
