Peanuts/Treenuts + Axe Spray

Dundas Central is a peanut and treenut safe school. We respectfully ask for the co-operation of parents and guardians with the school community to avoid sending nuts of any kind to school. We have a number of people in the building who have potentially life threatening allergies. Similarly, we ask that students not use their Axe body spray in the hallways or change rooms as this can cause breathing difficulties for people who have fragrance allergies and sensitivities.



Head Lice

From time to time, we have reported cases of pediculosis or head lice in the school. We have already had a few cases this year. We respectfully ask that if you discover your child has contracted a case of head lice, that you contact the school so that we may notify the other families in the class. If your child has signs of eggs, nits or live lice your child will bring home a letter to notify you. We ask that you treat your child, complete the form and return it to the school. Thank you to the small but mighty team of volunteers who have taken this job on. If you have time, and would like to volunteer, please let me know. I will connect you to the Lice Squad.
