Thank you to the playground community for taking care of our beautiful playground over the summer.

Although we know that you love your four legged family members we have students in our school that are either allergic or afraid of them. Therefore, we respectfully asked that you keep your dog off of school property when dropping off or picking up your child.

Please make sure you call the school (the answering machine is on 24/7) to report your child's lates and absences. If we are unaware of why your child is late or absent, it is entered as unexplained in the system.

Computer generated calls are made for all unexplained absences. If you do get a call you will need to listen to the entire message and confirm you have received it otherwise you will get repeat messages.

Fostering independence and building daily routines are a necessary and important practice at school. We respectfully ask that you allow your children to practice carrying their belongings and enter the school on their own. Please remember if you are in the building you **must** check in at the office. If you need to speak with your child's teacher, please book an appointment via the agenda or school office.

If you have any changes to phone numbers, emergency contacts or medical information please send a note to the office.

As always at this time of year, we send our enrollment numbers to the Board. Our numbers are fairly stable at this time, however re-organization is always a possibility. We will keep you informed over the next few weeks of any changes that may affect our classes at Dundas Central.

Please ensure that your child arrives on time for school each day. Important skills are learned and practiced daily as the students arrive and independently organize & start their day. If your child is going to be late, we ask that you call the school to report their late or absence and the reason for it.

Please note that playground supervision before school starts at 8:25 a.m. and after school ends at 3:15 p.m., therefore children can be dropped off at 8:25 a.m. (entry is 8:40 a.m.) and must be picked up before 3:15 p.m. each day.

NUTRITION BREAKS

You must notify the school in writing everytime your child leaves the school for lunch. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Also, just a reminder that Dundas Central is a **Peanut and Tree Nut Free** school. Please ensure that your child brings only peanut and tree nut free food items to school.
