Study space- West Campus. Mr. Del Sordo- students do not always have access to the library. They are able to use the resource room, cafeteria/mezzanine, front foyer- wireless, they can use their laptops.

Work Out Room- Mr. Del Sordo to look into teacher supervision. Also no cost for East but \$30/year for West campus. He will report back at next meeting.
