### Examination Routines

- Students are responsible to check the examination schedule to ensure that they have the correct date, time and location for their subject evaluations. A student who misses an examination for any reason, other than a documented medical or bereavement absence, may be assigned a mark of zero. All medical notes need to be brought to the Main Office at Dundas Valley within 24 hours of the exam.
- Students are responsible for arriving at the examination location by 8:30 am (morning exams) or 12:00 pm (afternoon exams) for attendance purposes. It is suggested that students arrive at least 5 minutes early. Specific room assignments for exams will be posted by classroom teachers.
- Students are responsible for arriving with the supplies (pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, calculator, etc.) necessary to write the examination. Please come prepared. Please return textbooks to classroom teachers.
- Students are not allowed, for any reason, to communicate with other students during an examination. Non-compliance may result in a loss of examination marks.
- Cell Phones/Electronic Devices – Absolutely **NO** personal electronic devices are to be on or in sight during the examination. Please **ensure** all cell phones are turned off.
- Students must check with their teacher to determine the length of their final evaluation. Students **MUST** remain in their exam for a minimum of **75 minutes**. Please be respectful that exams are still in progress and hallways must be clear and quiet.
- The library and resource room will **NOT BE OPEN** during regular exam times for quiet study. Students needing a place to work and study should report to the cafeteria.
