Prime Ministers Report - Regan

- Feedback from parents requested on Winter Semi Formal
 - Issues with traffic getting to Carmen's on time

 - Some food complaints
 - Overall, Winter Semi Formal had positive feedback

 - DVSS does hold a grade nine dance on site at the beginning of the school year
