Here is your important information for the week. We know you are feeling overwhelmed, as there is so much information coming at you right now. We understand where you are coming from – this can be both a very challenging and exciting time full of conflicting emotions. This happens every year at this time for grade 12's - the overwhelming feelings dissipate as you get through the process.

Please allow yourself the time to go through this carefully, as there are some dates you won't want to miss.

FULL DISCLOSURE

If a student drops a grade 11 or 12 course after the FULL DISCLOSURE DATE, the course appears on the official transcript as a WITHDRAWAL with the mark at the time of removal and a W beside it. If you plan to drop a current course, OCTOBER 26th is the last day of Quadmester 1 to drop it without it showing as a withdrawal.

POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION
