What is a Commencement?????

A commencement celebration is an opportunity to celebrate **every student in the Senior class** and their academic journey and achievements.

Every student will walk across the stage, while a two-sentence blurb written by the student is read out loud.

The purpose of the commencement is to celebrate Grade 12 students and speak to their transition into the next chapter of their education and career journey.

Caps and Gowns

- Students are given caps and gowns before commencement
- Students must arrive to commencement dressed in caps and gowns
- Students keep caps and gowns, they do not need to be returned

We ask that your guests remain in their seats during the ceremony as there is a professional photographer at the commencement who will be taking photos of students.

Accessibility

- The hall where the commencement is happening is on street level
- If you park underneath the convention center there is an elevator
- There is a ramp that students cross to get onto the stage

Consent

By you sending in the photos, it means you consent to your photo being viewed and you have confirmed consent with any others in the photos.

If you send in photos with other people (not just your self) you must make sure you have **their consent** as well.

Grad Bio's

When you walk across the stage at commencement, a short, personalized blurb about you that you submit will be read.



Grad Bio Guidelines

- The bios are written in the 3rd person.
- You can use humour, but it has to be school appropriate.
- The bios will be **proofread and possibly edited** for length/content/grammar.

Ms. Lawson and Ms. Warren are happy to help you if you aren't sure about what you've written!



What to Write in Your Bio

- GRATITUDE + WHAT'S NEXT = LOVELY BIO :)
- A) Write one sentence showing appreciation for your supporters: it's nice to start with parents/guardians/family, but you may wish to add a quick mention of friends/teachers/a school memory.
- B) Write one sentence sharing what's next

If you wish to not submit a bio, a variation of "DVSS staff wish *name* well in their future endeavours." will be read.



Examples

Jessie would like to thank their parents for their support over the past 14 years of school. Jessie will be attending Mohawk College for welding in September.

Sarah wants to give a shout out to the volleyball team and thank Ms. Davidson for all of the hours she put into coaching. Sarah will miss her fellow Gryphons, but is looking forward to a Gap year to figure out the next steps of her life's journey.
