UNIVERSITY PIN NUMBERS:

To start your application to university on OUAC, you need a personal identification number. This week, your demographic data and historical grades were uploaded to OUAC. QUEEN'S UNIVERSITY CHANCELLOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

Are you applying to Queen's University? Are you interested in being considered for the Chancellor's Scholarship? Check out the criteria



DVSS can only nominate one student for this scholarship, so it is important that you tell your guidance counselor you are interested in applying. Two important dates:

NOVEMBER 20th:

Apply for admission to Queen's via the [Ontario Universities Application Centre \(OUAC\)](#) no later than **November 20** to ensure that you gain access to SOLUS to submit your MAA application by December 8. It takes 4-6 business days to receive your SOLUS login from the date you applied to Queen's University.

DECEMBER 8TH:

The deadline to submit the Major Admission Award Application on SOLUS is **December 8, 2022**.

In celebration of its 150th anniversary (1841-1991), Queen's University offers 50 Chancellor's Scholarships to students chosen on the basis of nomination by high school principals and submission of a detailed application form. Students must be entering the first year of any undergraduate program at Queen's to qualify for a Chancellor's Scholarship. Students in their second year of CEGEP are also eligible to apply.

Nominations from institutions where the applicant is enrolled in part-time studies will not be accepted<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Students on a gap year must receive a nomination from their prior full-time high school. As there are restrictions on the number of nominees per school, it is up to the discretion of the High School Official whether to nominate a prior student over a student that is currently enrolled◦ A student from Quebec may receive a Chancellor's nomination from either their prior full-time high school or their current full-time CEGEP• Number of nominations per high school is based on graduating class size:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Less than 250 – 1 nominee◦ 250-499 – up to 2 nominees◦ 500 or greater – up to 3 nominees
