Skilled Trades will receive priority but soft Trades and apprenticeships will also be considered. What you need to do:


1. A complete résumé must be included with the application form.
2. 2 Letters of reference shall be provided

- A candidate must be enrolling in a full-time post-secondary educational co-op style program. This could be a Skilled Trade or similar technical program where hands-on work experience is combined with classroom training to achieve a provincial license in a trade recognized by the Ontario College of Trades or a TSSA (The Technical Standards and Safety) recognized discipline.
- A candidate must demonstrate **outstanding involvement in community and school extra-curricular activities.**
- A candidate may indicate financial need to pursue post-secondary education where applicable.
- A candidate must reside in Dundas or attended a local secondary school.
