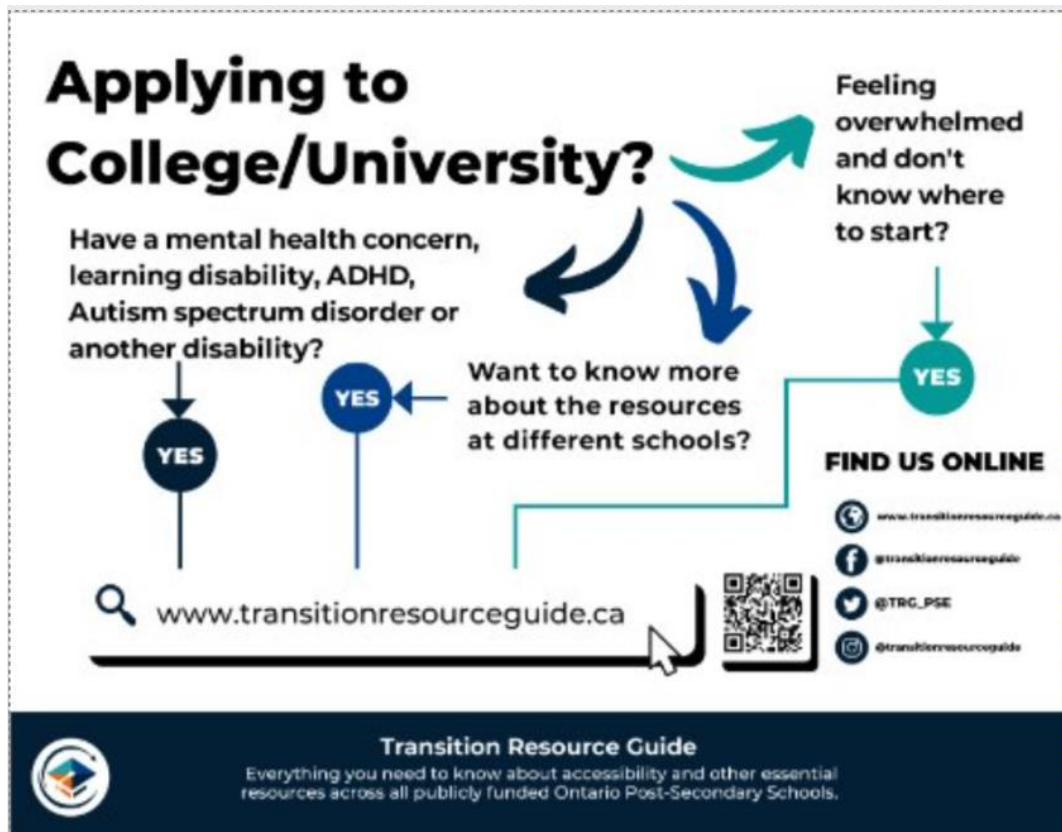
Start exporting your saved files and documents!
