A Bachelor of Arts (BA) is a university degree that focuses on subjects within the liberal arts, humanities, social sciences, languages and culture, and fine arts.





Additional Admission Criteria

A high school transcript is just 1 piece of information Queen's University uses when making an admission decision. Each applicant to Queen's has a personalized To Do List, detailing what exactly is needed to complete their application. Students can review their To Do List (and associated due dates) on their Queen's SOLUS Student Centre. Students will receive instructions for accessing SOLUS after they apply.

"Requirements" shows you what grade 12 courses you need to take to be able to apply as well as if there is a supplementary application required.

Requirements for all university programs in Ontario:

6 Grade 12 University or Mixed courses (4U/4M)

ENGLISH 4U is always one of the 6

Universities base admission offers primarily on the student's average which will include the marks in required courses and the next highest 4U/4M marks.

Are Grade 11 Marks Considered?

Some universities will consider grade 11 marks in required courses if the student has not yet completed the grade 12 course at the time the offer is being made.

Early offers of admission: Can happen in December

First round offers: February/March

Second round offers: April/May

What to expect from a career in Nursing

Nursing programs at Ontario colleges come at varying levels for those in or interested in the field. Courses meet the needs of current Registered Nurses looking to diversify their skills as well as future nurses looking to get started.

Patient care demands exceptional attention to detail and a compassion for those in need. If you have these things and you see yourself starting or continuing in nursing education, here's what you need to know.

Nursing Courses

Ontario college nursing programs cover the following areas:

- Pre-Health Sciences. A preparatory science and math program designed to satisfy entry requirements into other medical
 programs, including nursing.
- Practical Nursing. Two-year college diploma programs that teach the skills you need to become a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN), with an emphasis on clinical experience.
- Nursing Specialties. Teaching areas such as critical care nursing, operating room perioperative nursing, perinatal intensive care nursing and more, all of which build on training gathered as a Registered Nurse.
- Bachelor or Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Four-year degree programs that prepare students for work as Registered Nurses
 (RNs). RNs have a greater depth of knowledge and competency in the field of nursing than RPNs and have a greater range of care
 delivery options.

Many other nursing programs exist, so be sure to study complete program listings before making your choice.

General Nursing Program Requirements

All entry level nursing programs will require an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent, with a grade 12 English credit. Specific science and math credits may be required for different programs, and are always seen as an asset.

Nursing Jobs

Depending on your certification, nursing careers may include (but are not limited to) fields like:

- Acute care
- Community services
- · Health centres
- Long-term care institutions
- Hospitals

Licensed nurses may also serve as practitioners, educators and managers in the health field. Nurses also have options in the travel & tourism industry, as travel nurses are often in high demand.





Become a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) and pursue an exciting health care career that offers diverse opportunities.

Program Highlights

- Collaborative learning environment where you and your peers will experience simulated and reallife opportunities in state-of-the-art labs.
- Complete the program in 16 consecutive months and have a variety of academic pathways for further education and training.

The PN Program is a hybrid program to support study-life balance, with both online courses and inperson courses. Theory courses each semester are online with mandatory in-person midterm and final exams. Lab-based courses each semester have a 2hr in-person weekly lab on campus. Attendance at inperson lab is mandatory.

Professional practice courses (clinical) are in-person at health care agencies. Shifts may be scheduled during the week or on weekends. Semester 1 is two 7hr shifts per week, Semester 2 and 3 is one 12hr shift per week, and Semester 4 is 40 hrs per week for the final 7 weeks of the Semester (days, nights, weekend shifts).

Students choose their own timetable "block" each Semester, and courses can potentially be scheduled in the morning, afternoon, or evening. See "Program of studies" tab for more details on specific courses in each Semester.





Once families complete the form and submit it with all the required information, they will receive a notification that their submission has been received.


The form is titled 'eLearning Opt Out for Families'.
