



Welcome back students! Your senior year is a busy one. Starting off your school year with intention will be of great benefit to you. Let's start by looking at the costs of postsecondary education.

According to Statistics Canada, the average tuition fee for a full year of study was \$6,834 in 2022/2023. The average cost of college tuition for one academic year in a diploma program is \$2,400 while bachelor's degree programs cost approximately \$6,100. (Do keep in mind that tuition varies by program and province.). There are also other expenses to consider such as fees, textbooks, equipment, and supplies; residence + meal plan; and miscellaneous items, e.g., cell phone, clothing, recreation, transportation, etc.

Scholarships, bursaries, and awards can help to offset some of the costs of postsecondary education. Here are FIVE ways to increase your chances of receiving a scholarship, bursary, or award.

What are Supplementary Applications?

Supplementary applications are extra components that accompany some of our program applications. They help us learn more about you.

The format and requirements for each supplementary application vary depending on the program. Some are called "Electronic Creative Submissions" or "CASPer Assessments" which have different requirements. Make sure that you're aware of the requirements and deadlines for each program application.
