The first step in exploring trades and/or an apprenticeship in high school is to test out a trade by taking a Cooperative Education (co-op) course. When you take a coop, you are learning outside of the school by working under the direction of experienced workers, while completing credits towards your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) at the same time. Most students take co-op in Grades 11 or 12, but some may choose to start in the summer after Grade 10.

When your co-op placement is within one of the 140+ skilled trades, you are a participant in OYAP—the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP). OYAP is a coop education experience that helps students gain experience in a safe workplace and the opportunity to become registered apprentices in a skilled trade through co-op courses. Participating in OYAP can also help with the transition to employment.

When a student participates in OYAP, the student is supported by their co-op teacher to find an employer that is a good fit. Your co-op teacher can guide you through the apprenticeship process including assisting you with resume writing and interviewing.

With OYAP, you can:

- Explore and gain training in apprenticeship/skilled trade occupations.
- Earn credits for your high school diploma.
- · Develop employment skills.
- · Learn about safety and how job sites operate.
- Build a network for future employment in a trade.
- · Get a head start on a skilled trades career!


