#### SPECIALIZED PROGRAMMING NOTE:

Recommendations for specialized programming will be made using a team approach involving elementary and secondary school staffs, the student, and family/caregivers/guardians. Specialized programming in Grade 9 includes:

- Locally Developed courses in English (ENG1L), Math (MAT1L), Science (SNC1L), and French (FSF14)
- FSF101 can be chosen if the student has not had the minimum of 600 hours of elementary Core French instruction.



#### Ontario Graduation Requirements for Students Starting Grade 9 at Dundas Valley in 2025

#### WHAT ARE THE 17 REQUIRED CREDITS?

- 4 credits in English (1 per grade)
- 3 credits in math (grade 9, grade 10, and one in 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in tech education (grade 9 or 10)
- 1 credit in Canadian geography (grade 9)
- 1 credit in Canadian history (grade 10)
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies
- 0.5 credit in civics and citizenship

1 credit from the STEM-related course group

To graduate, students must earn 30 credits: 17 are required 13 are optional

### One credit will be earned from any of the following STEM-related courses:

Business studies
Computer studies
Cooperative education
Mathematics (beyond the 3 required)
Science (beyond the 2 required)
Technological education (beyond the 1 required)


