
# 40 Hours of Community Involvement

## What to understand about the eLearning experience:

- you will have one period to work on your eLearning course, but you can work on the course in the evening/at lunch
- students can work in the library, in the cafeteria, or at home
- **Learning Skills are very important to be successful in an eLearning course – independence, organization, time management and initiative are key habits**
