School Washrooms/Access

As we are a locked facility, and for the safety of all students, access to the school, and school washrooms is strictly for staff/students during regular school times. Students and parents are not allowed to access the school before or after bell times to use the washroom. If you are staying on the playground after school hours, you must make alternate arrangements for using the washroom. Please encourage your child to use the facilities prior to arriving or leaving the school.

Student Absence

If your child is going to be away from school, whether for illness, or personal reasons, please remember to call the school to let us know. Our school number is (905) 528-0223, and is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. This will ensure that we know that your child is safe. If you are planning to be away, you can also write a note to the teacher in the student's agenda.

Safe Student Drop-Off

For the safety of all students, when dropping children off in the morning, parents/caregivers are required to use the designated Kiss-n-Ride area, not the street. If you need to accompany your child to the school, you must park in the designated parking areas on the side streets, and walk the student to the school.
