Virtual Scholastic Book Fair ... thank you to our EK Home and School Association for organizing the first ever 'virtual' Book Fair for the school. As has previously been shared, any revenue earned is returned to the school by way of purchasing additional resources to support literacy programming and to keep kids reading. Over \$700 was raised this time around so thank you also EK families for participating and once again making this annual event a success!

Learn. Disrupt. Rebuild @ HWDSB: Building a Community of Care ... last year the Ministry of Education tasked all Ontario School Boards with having a plan in place to ensure inclusive environments in classrooms and in schools, free from discrimination. The 'LDR' initiative was created in response and has been in place since the start of the current school year. A significant amount of Professional Development continues to take place for staff and there are modules of age-appropriate instruction for students. Please ask your child's teacher for additional details if you are interested.

Pick up and Drop off (Stanley Avenue and Homewood Avenue) ... recently we've had neighbours of the school communicate their ongoing frustration with vehicles left blocking their driveways while caregivers presumably walk children to and from the playground. This may seem insignificant however we must remember that for homes along either side of the school, this is a twice daily concern for people getting into or out of their driveways. If you have to drive to the school, PLEASE do not block driveways as a courtesy to our EK neighbours.
