Hello everyone,

Hoping that everyone is keeping well and just wanted to share some items for your information and consideration:

February is Black History Month ... In February, we acknowledge Black History Month in schools and in communities across Canada. It is important for us to understand the long history and importance of the Black community to the development and enrichment of Canadian society. Black Canadians from many different cultural backgrounds have made important contributions to the development of education, medicine, culture and human rights throughout Canada's history. As well, we need to recognize how systemic oppression continues to create challenges and barriers. We traditionally celebrate Black culture and history while applauding the achievements and significant contributions Black Canadians have made to build Canada, helping to make this country the diverse and strong nation it is today. Teachers have access to a variety of supports and resources to facilitate age appropriate conversations and learning with students.

'Open Gym' (Intramurals) ... as was the case in the weeks leading up to the winter break, classes are once again able to sign up for time in the gym during Nutrition Breaks. We are currently restricted to having children only from the same class (cohort) participate together at any given time and yet regardless, a fun and active way for children to spend their time!

Library ... during the summer of 2020, the library at EK was renovated into a larger learning space by removing a pre-existing temporary wall and expanding to include the room next door. With the removal of some restrictions, and with us no longer needing to use the space as a classroom, this space now referred to as 'Learning Commons' is ready to go and children will once again be visiting and able to participate in book exchanges.
