With the winter weather here, please send in a pair of indoor shoes for your child. These shoes can be left at the school if you wish.

## After School Protocols

Just a friendly reminder that once school has been released, students and parents are asked to quickly disperse and not gather on school property. Due to safety concerns, students are not allowed to be climbing the trees on school property.



All students are required to wear masks indoors in school, including in hallways and during classes, as well as on school vehicles. Where physical distancing cannot be maintained, students are required to wear masks outdoors unless within their own cohort. Masks must cover the nose, mouth and chin without gaping. Bandanas, gators and face shields are not a replacement for masks.

Parents are also required to wear a mask while on school grounds, including drop-off and pick-up.



### Parking During Drop-Off/Pick-Up

Please ensure that you are **<u>NOT</u>** blocking **<u>ANY</u>** driveways during pick-up and drop-off. Many residents have called the school complaining that they cannot get in and out of their own driveways. Several neighbours have called the city, and parking enforcement will be monitoring and ticketing as needed. Please be respectful, and if necessary, park further away, and walk to the school.
