Term 2 Reprt cards ... T2 Reports were given out to students who were present on Monday, June 27th. For those children not present this week, the reports are mailed out to families directly.

Class Placement / Teacher information for September 2022 ... this information will be given to students on the final day of school (Wednesday, June 29th). For any students not present on this day, families can begin reaching out to the school the week of Monday, August 29th. Just so all are aware, this (class placement) is another example of information that will be moving to the Parent Portal in the future. Families will apparently be directed to log in the week prior to the start of school to find teacher and class information.

School reopening 2022/2023 ... while the first day for most children is Tuesday, September, 6th (after labour day), Elementary Schools are 'open for business' the week of Monday, August 29th apart from Thursday, September 1st (a PA Day for staff training and PD). JK and 'new to SK' students come in by appointment on September 6th and all FDK students are here as of September 7th.

Class Building ... the class building process in Elementary Schools generally begins in late April and takes several weeks for us to complete for the end of June while we work to ensure that classes are balanced in numerous ways while also doing our best to maintain at least a 'friend or two' for new classes in the fall. All staff play a part and we go through several drafts before completing our final class lists.
