### **School Updates**

### **Bus Loading Zone**

The bus loading zone in front of the school **MUST be kept clear from 7am-5pm.** This area is not to be used for student drop off or pick up as busses arrive and depart at various times during the day. Signs are posted in this area indicating no stopping, and vehicles will be tagged and towed.
