Winter is approaching and hopefully you're all keeping well. Just wanted to share some items for your information as we approach the winter break;

- o Last day of school prior to the winter break is Friday, December 23rd
- o First day back from the break is Monday, January 9th

Speaking of winter, it is important to remember that wet shoes and boots cannot be worn in the gym (for safety). Please ensure that your child has 'inside' running shoes in order to ensure active participation in Phys-Ed class (students are welcome to leave a pair at school).

Fright night 2022 ... after a few years hiatus, the long-standing tradition of 'Fright Night' made a wonderful comeback this fall due to the incredible efforts of numerous parent volunteers. You will hear more directly from the folks who make up our School Council and Home & School Association however we learned recently that close to \$9000.00 was raised ... bravo!

Wesley Holiday Store ... we are currently collecting non-perishable food items and new (unwrapped) toys that will be donated for distribution to needy children, adolescents and families. Lockdown Drill ... as part of our ongoing due diligence around safety planning, school are required to perform two 'Lockdown Drills' each school year. Messaging for students is always age-appropriate and we treat these much like we do the required Fire Drills each year. The first Lockdown Drill for the current school year is planned for the morning of Friday, December 9th.

Daily School Route (DSR) ... recently you should have received communication regarding the DSR initiative which is being piloted at EK and several other schools. Daily School Route is an active transportation system for children and families and the goal is to get more students walking and/or biking to school as it has been shown to improve their day emotionally, cognitively and physically. Families were asked to complete a short (5-minute) survey and the results along with possible next steps will be shared with us at our January 24th School Council meeting.

Spring Musical ... given the excitement in the building of late, I would imagine that many of you are already aware that we are preparing once again to perform a spring musical. Auditions for the **Wizard of Oz** were completed and rehearsals are happening weekly as Mr. Popek and Mme Prevec prepare numerous students in Grades 3, 4 and 5 for their parts. Watch for more information to come in the new year and our current plan is to hold evening performances the week of May 15th.
