Kindergarten Registration

Registration opened on-line for kindergarten registration on Monday, February 6, 2023. Children born in 2019 are eligible to enroll for JK starting in September. Students that are currently in JK do not have to re-register for SK. On the HWDSB website, click on "How to Register", then scroll down to 2023-24 Online Registration Link. You are also able to attach all required documents (proof of address, proof of age) to the registration. Should any additional information be required, the school will reach out to the families individually. Any families unable to attach their documents will also be contacted directly by the school. Please allow a minimum of 2 weeks after submitting your registration for the school to contact you.

Kindergarten Orientation

Orientation for all registered kindergarten students and parents will be on Wednesday, May 10th at 6:00pm. You will be able to come in to see various classrooms, meet the various teachers, and ask any questions you may have. More specific information will be forwarded to families closer to the date.



Parking on Side Streets
