- Lots of Field trips are planned
  - Many places are not open
  - o Busing is very expensive and very limited

- Grade 2 is trying to get Little Rays coming in
  - o GR 2 inquire if there is a subsidy (current cost \$15.8 per kid)
- Grade 1 looking into Green Venture (topic about worms, 2 groups)
- 100th day celebration for Gr1 & Gr2

  - o Volunteers would be needed (setup, cleaning utensils, 1+2 schoolblock)
