DSR (Daily School Route) EK is pilot project

- Daniel Chung, Paul Shaker and Maureen Wilson, Mark Chamberlain (Bike for Mike)
- Presentation by Daniel Chung: Currently in Review of all Ward 1 schools, Walk to school Rate, Route review, mode of transportation, they are currently working with 25 schools in Hamilton
- Why active transportation: help kids reach 60 mins of activity, stress relieve before school, direct sunlight, prepares brain for learning, replaces car trips.
- Target: 33 000 live within 1.6 km of school (walking distance). Only 60% of those walk
- Challenges: Neighborhood not designed for walking, traffic safety, family convenience
- Students streets should be: safe, convenient, attractive
- Operations of DSR Operation: (engagement, Understanding, Planning, implementation, evaluation)

Survey Results:

- 124 family responses (35% of school)
- 88% walk to school
- 2% talk school bus
- 9% usually drive
- 91 % of students live within 1.6km
- Top reasons to encourage walking
 - Improved street safety (52%)
 - o Designated routes to school (19%)
 - More people walking/wheeling (12%)
 - Different bell times.
- Heat map for most used school ways
- Top safety concerns:
 - Major crossing along east-west corridors

- (Crossing Queen, Crossing Dundurn)
- o Travelling along Dundurn
- Lack of sidewalks and accessibility issues.
