Lunches

Parking

Please be respectful of our neighbours when dropping off or picking up students. Do not block driveways, park on the sidewalk, park in the bus zone, or park where it is not permitted. It may seem like a short stop, however, the safety of all students and staff has to be the top priority. Should you choose to drive, you may need to park a bit further away and walk. Parking enforcement is regularly in the area, and will ticket accordingly.



Walking Trip Forms

Last week, permission forms were sent home for all students to be able to participate in walking trips around the school. If you have not done so, please complete and return this form to your child's teacher as soon as possible, as some classes are starting to plan outings.

Student verification forms will be sent home in the next few weeks. Please review the information on these forms (address, emergency contact, phone numbers etc.), and make any necessary changes in writing on the actual form. These forms need to be returned to the school as soon as possible so that we can ensure accurate and up-to-date information for all students.

Sending Information Home

Unless a form is required for each student, items such as Newsletters etc., will be sent home "youngest and only". This means that the youngest sibling at the school, or the only child at the school will be bringing things home.
