Signage will go up that shows walking duration to EK School (students will be involved to decide where to put signage)

Neighbor to Neighbor starts on October 23<sup>rd</sup> to Friday November 3<sup>rd</sup> (Food donations) Nickafor is the Contact Person for this initiative (last year over 6000 cans where donated)

EQAO received by school, the individual results will come in later

The only problem area is Math where EK is below Provincial Average; will be addressed in PA day

What is the difference between the different School boards on how they perform in this test (HWDSB does their Math instructions in French other boards don't do it)

Celebrations in Schools: often discussed topic to be inclusive...

- Engage communities/families with assemblies (holiday concerts)
- Explore the option maybe to do a concert at an external location (theatre Aquarius; Sarah has good contacts to get this organized)

Crossing guards are separate from HWDSB, only run by Hamilton City

- Communication to the Community if there is/is not crossing guard
- Know what the Crossing Guard policies are
- Dave to send out notification letter to parents to inform them, that Crossing Guards are run by Hamilton City and not HWDSB
- Also send out note, the City is responsible for salting of SideWalks

## Amended Agenda Topic: English Course perception

Ashley: Concern, that enrollment is so low that they take away program and those kids will be bussed to different schools. How to be proactive in marketing the English Program, battle the negative Perception of English program
